Formal Education:- Formal Education plays an important role in environmental awareness. Environmental awareness should be providing like other subjects. It should be weightaged same as other core subjects are given. It should be more practical. A rich curriculum should be designed and implemented to achieve its objectives.

Co-curricular activities:- Co-curricular activities play a crucial role in achieving aims of education. Environmental awareness is no exception of it. There are many co-curricular activities that enhance environment awareness. Environmental camps and lectures, environmental awareness programmes like exhibitions and movies on environmental awareness, environmental discussion like seminars, conference, debates etc. focus our attention to environment. This will help to impart the environmental awareness.

Informal education: - Informal education also helps to create environmental awareness among people. People may form eco clubs and may have discussions about the serious aspects of environment so that it may handle properly.

Parents and guardians should tell the importance of environment and they should inspire their wards to programmes that may create awareness to environment like Environmental Education. Awareness and Training (EEAT), is a flagship scheme of a Ministry for enhancing the understanding of people at all levels about the relationship between human beings and environment and to develop skills to improve and product the environment. Also, Swachh Bharat Mission is also another flagship which was launched on 2nd October 2014 by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India with the view to bring about improvement in the general quality of life by promoting cleanliness, hygiene and eliminating open defecation, to accelerate sanitation coverage in rural areas to achieve the vision of Swachh Bharat, to motivate communities and Panchayati Raj Institutions to adopt sustainable sanitation practices and facilities through awareness creation and health education, to encourage cost effective and appropriate technologies for ecologically safe and sustainable sanitation, to develop community managed sanitation systems focusing on scientific Solid & Liquid Waste Management systems for overall cleanliness, to create significant positive impact on gender and promote social inclusion by improving sanitation especially in marginalized communities. ODF programme, Solid Waste Management, Wet Waste Processing, Dry Waste Processing,

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Sanitary Landfills. Legacy Dumpsite Remediation, Clean Green Campaign, Indian Swachhta League, Swachhta Ke Do Rang, Swachhta Talks, Swachhta Startup Conclave, Swachh Amrit Mahotsav, Swachh Sehar Samvad etc. are some initiatives and programmes under Swachh Bharat Mission which are proved to be a milestone in making clean India and healthy environment. Further, Swachhta App and Swachhtm Portal are some ICT enabled platforms which facilitate grievance redressal platform to public for submitting any complaint regarding cleanliness and integrated interface between Ministry, State and Urban Local Bodies for all activities respectively. Similarly, other non-government organizations should start such programmes that may create environmental awareness and may prove fruitful to protect environment.

Customs, traditions and environmental awareness: - Traditions and customs have profound influence on environment and its various components. Their influence on environment may be both positive and negative. - a. At primary level, students should be given the basic knowledge of environment and its elements like, atmosphere, trees, rivers etc. It should be done with real situation or real objectives as possible e.g. If a teacher wants to teach about tree, one should take their students outside the class to see the trees to students, so that they may grasp properly the concept and also learn the concerned.
- b. Students should be made aware to neighbourhood environment at upper primary level and they should be asked to seek the problems and be motivated to give the solution of the problems. They should be known about different type of element of environment and their relation and effect on human being.

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They should be felt this sense while studying environmental education. They should be made familiar with the dangerous outcomes if environment polluted.

- c. At secondary or senior secondary level, there should be more practical and less theoretical evaluation. Practical evaluation should be more weightaged in overall evaluation of environment subject. They should be assigned small projects that prompt environment awareness and should be evaluated accordingly.
- d. At higher level, environment subject should not be optional or elective. This should be compulsory subject in syllabus. It should be divided into two sections (i) theoretical, (ii) practical. Theory should be appropriate weightage for both the sections. Theory must include seminars/conferences/workshops conducted by higher education institutions while in practical, there should be project like ODF (Open Defecation Free, clean village, Green village etc.) programmes to create environment awareness. Criteria must be to qualify in both the sections by students.

Conclusion- Environmental awareness is very necessary among citizens of the country to keep environment clean and healthy for wellbeing of human being. Although, it is a difficult task in this age of science and technology, yet attempts can be made for the same having a ray of hope. And in this task, education can play a significant role to resolve the environmental issues. So, this is a great matter of concern where everyone should focus. Without proper environment, human life cannot be sustained and how education can achieve its aim ignoring the issues of environmental awareness. So, it has become a great challenge to us, and if it should not be sort out soon, there will be dangerous outcomes to us and our future generation.
